## List of Supplies for a Trip (insulin pump)

Before I leave, I make sure to bring enough supplies (<u>ideally in duplicate</u>) to face any possible unforeseen events on my trip.

I also make sure that I'm familiar with the precautions to take on sick days.

Capillary blood sugar meter with test strips, lancing device, lancets and batteries ( <u>even if</u> I'm leaving with a continuous glucose monitoring system)
Continuous glucose monitoring system (if applicable) with spare sensors and transmitters (if needed)
Insulin (+/- case to keep it cool if there is a risk of extremely high temperatures)
Insulin pump (+ spare insulin pump) with infusion sets
Needle cutter
Emergency kit with syringes + insulin vial (or pen with insulin cartridges), batteries or spare cable, ketone body measurement device (+ test strips), enough quick-acting sugar to treat two hypoglycemic episodes, injectable or nasal glucagon
Illness kit with medication for diarrhea, vomiting, motion sickness, etc.
Snacks
A medical ID (e.g., MedicAlert®).
Other:
<u>Documents:</u> My pump settings, pump back up plan in case of a problem with my pump, travel letter, list of medications and required supplies from my pharmacist, etc.
